WHERE DO I START?

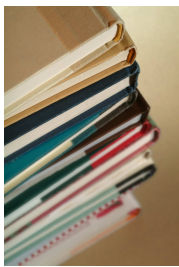
NSW OH&S Regulations 2001 states: The principal contractor must prepare an OHS management plan at any place of work at which construction work exceeds \$250,000 or if there is *High Risk Activities undertaken on site. The plan must be maintained and kept up to date during the course of the work.
